If, after applying the above suggested remedy, the weapon still fails to fire, you will have to temporarily sling your rifle, or when you have time, perform a close, visual examination and diagnosis. When a round is stuck in the chamber and will not extract, or there is some other snarl which cannot be remedied quickly, you will have to rely on your pistol or another weapon temporarily and attend to the problem later, when the tactical situation subsides.
